

REPORT ON THE OBSERVANCE OF VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK 2021 AT ICAR- CPCRI, REGIONAL STATION, KAYAMKULAM

Vigilance Awareness Week 2021 was observed at ICAR- CPCRI, Regional Station Kayamkulam from 26th October 2021 to 1st November 2021 with the theme Independent India @75: Self reliance with Integrity". The inaugural session commenced at 11.00 AM on 26.10.2021 by taking integrity pledge by all Staff members of the Station. Dr. S. Kalavathi, Acting Head in her address highlighted the relevance of the theme "Self reliance with Integrity" under the context of 75 years of independence. She called up on the staff members to be committed, accountable and transparent in their duties so as to attain self reliance at individual, societal and national level. Dr. P. Muralidharan, PS & Head, KVK, Alappuzha delivered a special talk on 'Self Reliance with Integrity' which was well received by the audience.
