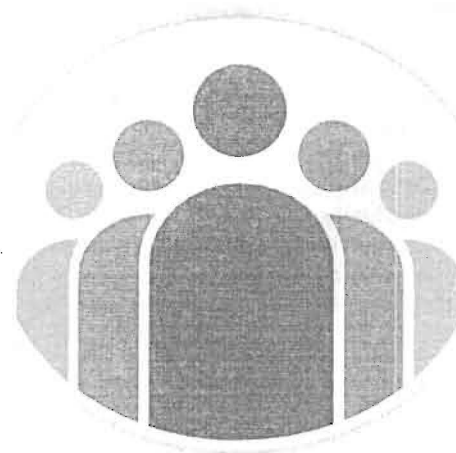

The ICAR-National Academy of Agricultural Research Management (NAARM), Hyderabad announces a Management Development *Programme on Leadership Development (a pre-RMP programme)* from 19-30 December, 2016 at Hyderabad

Background

Research points out that the best research organizations and universities are led by top academic persons. Researchers in the system, therefore, need to be identified and groomed to take up leadership positions in organizations. It is known that the personal styles and the personality characteristics of leaders show wide variability. The fact that different situations call for different types of leadership is also well documented. A complex array of knowledge, skills, and abilities appears to constitute effectiveness of leaders. The present leadership literature, with its focus on effective leaders, revisits personal traits, leader behaviour, research and technology management, and administration and finance management as essential determinants of leadership development.

Heads of the Divisions and other senior functionaries, who are in the pre-Research Management Positions (pre-RMPs) in the National Agricultural Research System (NARS) play a very important bridge role in the organization, and they take up leadership responsibilities in many activities that they perform. In fact, this role enables them metamorphose gradually, over a period of time, to take up the future leadership role in research institutions. Knowledge workers, who constitute the major segment of agricultural research organizations, definitely require a different way of being managed, and they look forward to a different type of leadership role and persona. The programme would provide an opportunity for the pre-RMPs, who are in the "middle zone", to develop smooth and gradual transformation to step into future leadership position.

Objectives

- To help participants understand their own personality dimensions
- To explore leadership challenges and core competencies needed in present day context
- To develop understanding and skills in research and technology management information and knowledge management, and administration and finance management
- To adapt ideas of diverse skills for sharpening capacities to effectively execute various roles in the organization

Content

The programme would cover the following broad areas:

- Leadership and personality development
- Research and technology management
- Information and knowledge management

- Administration, finance, and vigilance management

Methodology

The programme will consist of a blend of lectures, self-exploration instruments, and case analysis, experiential learning, and group discussion. The programme will provide an excellent opportunity for mutual interaction and information sharing among the participants.

Programme fee

Non-ICAR participants: Rs 15,000/- which includes training kit/material, board and lodging charges of NAARM Guesthouses/Hostels excluding TA/DA. For the participants from ICAR, there is no registration fee, however, they have to pay board and lodging charges at an approximate cost of Rs 600/- per day. The programme fee may be paid through a demand draft drawn in favour of "ICAR Unit-NAARM", payable at Hyderabad; sent along with the Nomination Form. Payment can also be made during registration. The information should be mentioned on the reverse side of the Demand Draft, please include the details like programme title; name of the participant and office address.
