



#### Background

The leadership role of scientists is expanding to a new scale, and element of new environment challenges are opening a new horizon for environmental management. coordination of grant proposals, writing papers and assigning intellectual property rights. Thus, the programme offers an opportunity to learn life skills that can be applied to a wide Range of situations, i

The course is based on **Smithsonian Environmental Leadership course** of USA and will involve self-exploration and discovery, as well as interaction among the scientists who will share their experiences regarding challenges they faced in people management.
