

Campco to launch 'Kalpa' dark chocolate

MANGALURU: Campco will launch its new product 'Kalpa', the dark chocolate at the Kisan Mela and exhibition 'Centenary Expo' to be held at Central Plantation Crops Research Institute (CPCRI), Kasargod, between December 10 and 13, stated a press release.

The Kisan Mela will be organised by ICAR -Central Plantation Crops Research Institute, Kasargod, on the occasion of their centenary celebrations.

Union Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare Minister Radha Mohan Singh will inaugurate and release 'Kalpa' to the market. It is a swadeshi product manufactured by Campco in association with ICAR-CPCRI.

'Kalpa' has been prepared out of cocoa and coconut and is a nutrient chocolate, according to Campco and CPCRI. In the process of manufacturing, caramelicious palm sugar is derived from the sap of coconut blossoms produced with the technology imparted by ICAR-CPCRI using Cocoa Sap Chiller Technology. It digests slowly, causing milder upswings in blood sugar due to its low glycemic index and provides more stable energy. Rich in potassium, magnesium, iron and other minerals, Vitamin E, B and C including dietary fibres.

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
