- 1. Crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications.
- 2. Age relaxation shall be allowed to SC/ST/OBC/Physically handicapped candidates to the extent permissible under the Govt. of India rules. Relaxation in upper age limit shall be subject to submission of requisite SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer) certificate furnished in the format prescribed by Govt. of India.
- 3. Only Indian Nationals need apply.
- 4. Candidates should give a declaration stating whether he/she is related to any employee of CPCRI or any other ICAR Institute and if so, the name of the person(s) and the nature of his/her relationship, is to be described in the application without fail.
- 5. Application should be submitted strictly in the prescribed format, which can be downloaded from CPCRI, Kasaragod website <a href="https://www.cpcri.gov.in">www.cpcri.gov.in</a>. Recent passport size colour photograph duly attested by a gazetted officer <a href="must be">must be</a> affixed at the space provided in the application form.
- 6. Application form should specify the advertisement No. and name of the post.
- 7. A candidate must submit along with each completed application a crossed Demand Draft / IPO for ₹300/- (Non refundable) as application fee (drawn in favour of ICAR Unit, CPCRI, Kasaragod). No other means of payment will be accepted. No fee for SC/ST/PH and female candidates. The candidate should on the reverse-side of the crossed DD/IPO indicate his/her name, address, name of the post applied for. The application form not accompanied with the application fee will be rejected and the date of the DD should not be prior to the date of the issue of the Advertisement in the Employment News/News Paper.
- 8. Applications not in prescribed format, incomplete applications, unsigned applications, application without fee, applications without mentioning name of the post are liable to be rejected.
- 9. The application completed in all respects along with duly supported attested copies of educational / technical qualification, caste certificates in the appropriate form prescribed by Govt. of India, certificate in proof of age, experience certificates, application fee etc., should reach the Director, ICAR-CPCRI, Post Kudlu, Kasaragod-671124, Kerala State within 30 days from the date of publication of this advertisement in Employment News/News Paper. - 11. No Travelling Allowance will be paid to the candidates called for written test. However, unemployed SC candidates called for written test will be paid second class train fare as per Govt.of India rules(on production of proof).
- 12. The selected candidates will be posted either at Institute's headquarters at Kasaragod or at any Regional Stations / Research Centre under CPCR1. However, they will be liable to serve in any Institute of ICAR located anywhere in India.
- 13. # SCHEME OF EXAMINATION FOR LOWER DIVISION CLERKS

## PART-I

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION: The examination will consist of a written examination and Typing Test for the post of Lower Division Clerks.

# (A) SCHEME OF THE WRITTEN EXAMINATION AND SYLLABUS

The written examination will consist of one objective type paper as shown below:

NOTE-I: The paper will consist of Objective Type-Multiple Choice questions only. The questions will be set both in English & Hindi.

NOTE-11: There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this in mind while answering the questions.

### **SYLLABUS**

General Intelligence: It would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal type. The test will include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discriminating observation, relationship concepts, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series etc. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidates' abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

NB

English Language: In addition to the testing of candidates' understanding of the English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc. his/her writing ability would also be tested.

Numerical Aptitude: This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, use of Tables and Graphs, hlensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and Work, etc.

General Awareness: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate"s general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

NOTE: For VH candidates of 40% and above visual disability and opting for SCRIBE there will be no component of Maps/Graphs/Diagrams/Statistical Data in the General Intelligence & Reasoning/ General Awareness Paper.

(B) Skill Test for LDCs: (Skill Test will be taken on Computer)

Typing Test will be of Qualifying in nature.

English Typing @ 35 w.p.m. (Time allowed 10 minutes) (30 minutes for VH candidates) Hindi Typing @ 30 w.p.m. (Time allowed 10 minutes) (30 minutes for VH candidates)

(35 w.p.m. and 30 w.p.m. corresponds to 10500 Key Depressions Per Hour/9000 Key Depressions Per Hour on an average of 5 key depressions for each wurd)

(Typing Test will be conducted later for those candidates who qualify in the Written Examination. Such Typing Test will be conducted only in English or Hindi and candidates while applying tor the Examination will have to indicate his/her choice/option for Skill Test Medium separately in the Application Form.)
