





natural justice namely no one should be made a judge in his own cause is given a go bye. In the instant RTI query, entire information

requisitioned by the Appellant incidentally pertains to the CPIO (Shri. Suresh Kumar) and thus duly exploiting the statutory position of CPIO, had acted with a malafide intent and suppressed the information sought under the RTI act. It is evident that the CPIO is misusing his authority to hide official information pertaining to him, which may perhaps help bring his misdeeds in the public domain.

The FAA may examine the appeal giving due credence to the infirmity in the act of the CPIO pointed out above and pass a favourable decision and not to passively uphold the illegal act of the CPIO, (who happens to be his Head of Office), in the interest of upholding the principles of fairness:
