Sir,

Your quotation cited above, to execute the work 'Providing roof covering and RAMP to connect the pre-processing coconut shed and BPD building (Southern side) near south block' at ICAR-CPCRI Kasaragod at a total cost of Rs.4,34,198/- (Rupees Four lakh thirty four thousand one hundred and ninety eight only) (including tax) has been accepted by the Competent Authority and accordingly the work is hereby awarded to you for execution. You are therefore requested to take up the work and complete the same within 45 days. The order is further subject to the following terms and conditions.

#### Terms and conditions:

- 1. The work should be executed strictly as per the directions from the Dr.R Pandiselvam, Scientist / Shri K Ajithkumar, K, TO (CE) of the Institute from time to time.
- 2. The Institute will not be responsible for any loss/damage/casualty suffered by the Contractor while executing the work, provided there wasn't any mistake on the part of the contractor.
- 3. Any loss or damage etc. caused to the Institute properties while carrying out the work should be made good failing which necessary action will be initiated to recover the cost of the same.
- No work tools/implements will be supplied by this Institute.
- The payment will be made only after satisfactory completion of the whole work to our satisfaction & as per specification.
- No part payment is payable.
- 7. Non-completion of the work or part thereof for any invalid reasons within the period prescribed is liable for cancellation and no claims for such works will be entertained under any circumstances and deposits made thereof will be forfeited.
- 8. Not less than minimum rate of wages fixed for the respective category should be paid to the workers. All requirements under labour laws should be fulfilled
- 9. Defects liability period: Performance Security will be released after sixty days from the liability period (6 months) from the date of completion of the work provided that the contractor has attended to all the complaints informed to him within the liability period.
- 10. The contractor or his worker should not use the office toilets and should not waste the water from the office building.
- 11. Any defective workmanship found shall be rectified at his cost which may include the materials spoilt/wasted paints due to negligence etc.
- 12. The contractor shall, on written request of the Director or his representative on the site, immediately dismiss from the work any person employed by him thereon, who may in the opinion of the Director be incompetent or misbehaves himself and such persons shall not again be allowed to work without the written permission of the Director.
- 13 Os completion of the work it should be chanced that premises & its surroundings are cleaned (including removal of paints fallen etc.)

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- 14. Prior permission may be obtained for electricity/water facility, if required, subject to payment for the same.
- 15. Income Tax will be deducted as per rule from the work bill. GST and other tax if applicable will be paid directly to the concerned department by the contractor as per rule and same show in the final bill. Further after remittance copy of the same should be furnished at this Office. The performance security amount will be released after getting the GST details.
- 16. Prior approval shall be obtained for the material used for the work from Engineer in-charge
- 17. Any compensation paid to the worker or parties hired through contractor, shall be recovered from the contractor as per the guidelines issued by ICAR vide OM No.Admn-22(6)/2018-Estt.III dated 31.07.2018
- 18. The period of 45 days allowed for carrying out the work will be reckoned after 5 days from the date of receipt of this order.
- 19. The contractor shall debit the Performance Security within 7 days from the issue of work order. The period can be further extended at the written request of the contractor for the period of 10 days with late fee at the rate of 0.1% per day of Performance Security amount.
- 20. The work should be completed within the time limit itself failing which the work order will be cancelled and action taken to complete the remaining work at your risk and cost including forfeiture of security deposit.
- 21. In case any extension of time is granted beyond the stipulated period for completion of the work due to any unavoidable genuine circumstances as may be decided by the competent authority, penalty clause to be imposed @ 0.25% per month (maximum to 2.5% of the total cost of the work) if work not completed within schedule time or within mutually extended period.
- 22. The Director of this Institute reserves the right to reject the work as a whole, if the execution is not satisfactory or does not conform to the approved specification.
- 23. In the event of change of address, that may be informed to the office immediately.
- 24. The water charges @ 1 % shall be recovered on gross amount of the work done. The Contractor shall make his/their own arrangement of water connection and laying of pipelines from existing main of source of supply. The Institute do not guarantee to maintain uninterrupted supply of water and it will be Incumbent on the contractor(s) to make alternative arrangements for water at his/ their own cost in the event of any temporary break down in the Government water main so that the progress of his/their work is not held up for want of water. No claim of damage or refund of water charges will be entertained on account of such break down 1% of the billed amount towards water charges will be recovered, if water for the work is supplied by the Institute.
- 25. Deduction for **electricity charges** either on actual basis or at the rate of 0.50% of the billed amount will be made if the electricity is supplied by the Institute.
- 26. The rates quoted in the Financial bid shall be treated as final rates and no escalation of rates shall be entertained.
- 27. The payment shall be released only after the final bill is submitted by the contractor after Physical completion of work and as per the actual measurements at Site. No part Payment/supplementary/enhanced/revised shall be considered in any circumstances.
- 28. 10% the total amount quoted shall be deposited with the Institute by means of DD as **Performance** security within 7<sup>th</sup> days of the award of the work.
- 29. The agency has to abide by rules and regulations pertaining to labour act. The Contractor has to take all necessary steps for the welfare measures of labour employed at Site.
- 30. The agency is fully responsible for providing medical facilities to their labourers in case of any accident etc. Matters related to labour welfare/problems should be dealt by the contractor only. CPCRI, Kasaragod shall not be responsible in such matters.

31. Legal jurisdiction for all disputes shall be within the purview of the Kasaragod courts

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32. No labour of the contractor will be allowed to stay within the campus/site of the work.

33. The work shall be executed as per the approved specification and CPWD norms.

34. The decision of the Competent Authority shall be final to select the competent firms/contractors.

35. When the annual repairs and maintenance of works are carried out, the splashes and droppings from white washing, color washing, painting etc., on walls, floor, windows, etc shall be removed and the surface cleaned simultaneously with the completion of these items of work in the individual rooms, quarters or premises etc. where the work is done: without waiting for the actual completion of all the other items of work in the contract. In case the contractor fails to comply with the requirements of this clause, the Engineer-in-Charge/OIC (M) shall have the right to get this work done at the cost of the contractor either departmentally or through any other agency. Before taking such action, the Engineer-in-Charge/OIC (M) shall give ten days notice in writing to the contractor.

You may remit a Performance Security of Rs.43,420/-Rupees Forty three thousand four hundred and twenty only) being the 10% of contract value by DD, FD Receipt or Bank Guarantee from the Commercial Bank in an acceptable form in favour of "ICAR Unit, CPCRI Kasaragod" in case of DD & Bank Guarantee.

Please acknowledge receipt of this order and confirm acceptance within 7 days from the date of receipt of this letter.


